



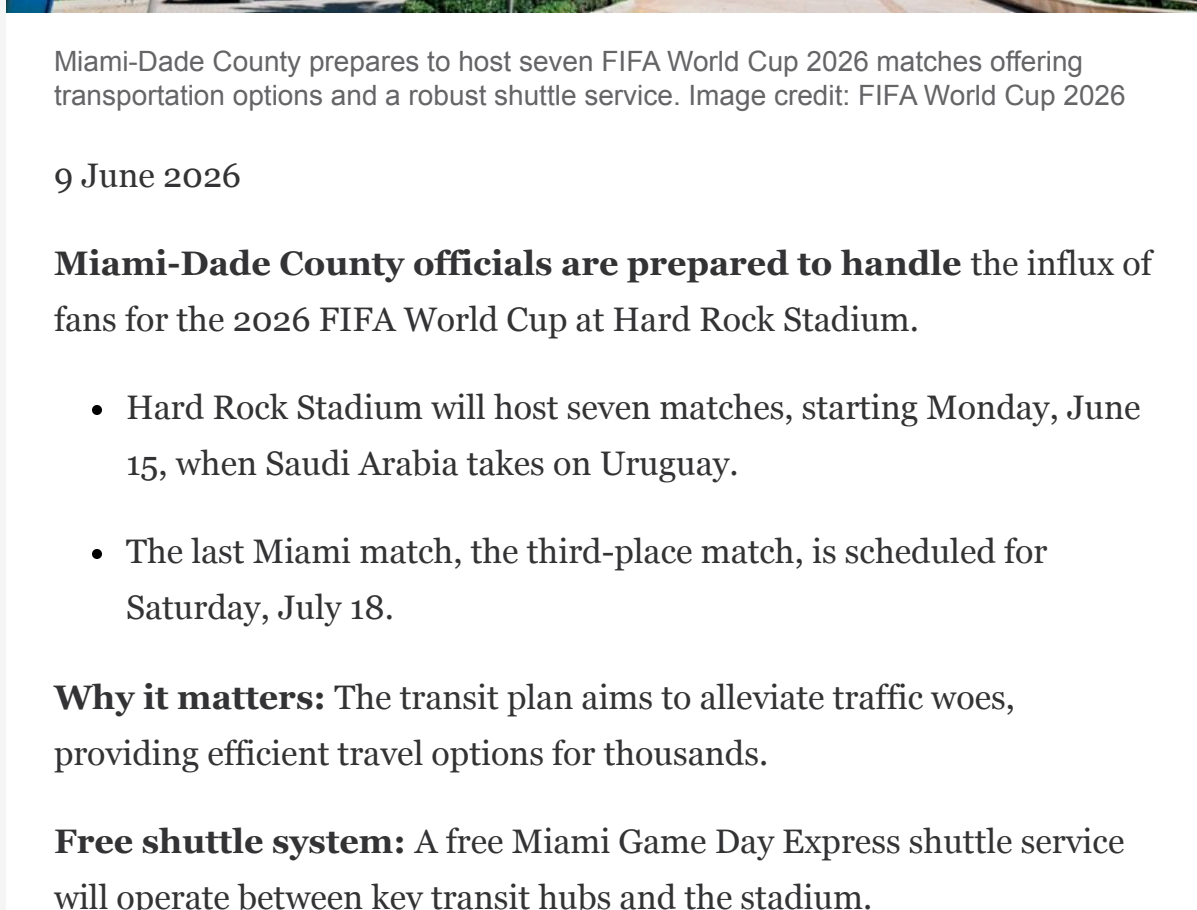

## Miami-Dade's transit system prepared for FIFA World Cup 2026

**Miami-Dade County officials are prepared to handle** the influx of fans for the 2026 FIFA World Cup at Hard Rock Stadium.

- Hard Rock Stadium will host seven matches, starting Monday, June 15, when Saudi Arabia takes on Uruguay.
- The last Miami match, the third-place match, is scheduled for Saturday, July 18.

**Why it matters:** The transit plan aims to alleviate traffic woes, providing efficient travel options for thousands.

**Free shuttle system:** A free Miami Game Day Express shuttle service will operate between key transit hubs and the stadium.

- **Hubs include:** Brightline Aventura Station, Martin Luther King Jr. Metrorail Station, Golden Glades Parking Garage, and Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino.
- **Service details:** Shuttles start 3.5 hours before matches, with continuous service until fans return safely.
- **Shuttle buses:** The county is planning to use nearly 200 buses to move fans to and from the designated transit hubs.

**Brightline and Tri-Rail options:** Brightline offers round-trip tickets between \$76 and \$150, providing a premium transit experience.

**Tri-Rail:** A budget-friendly alternative, with tickets ranging from \$2.50 to \$6.90, depending on the starting station. Weekend round-trip travel is available for \$5.

**Metro services:** Regular Metrorail and Metrobus services remain active, with added routes to accommodate game-day traffic.

**Metromover:** The Metromover will continue to operate until midnight each day, with extended service hours until 1 a.m. for events at the fan festival in Bayfront Park.

**Threat environment:** The overall crime threat at Hard Rock Stadium (Miami Stadium) is low.

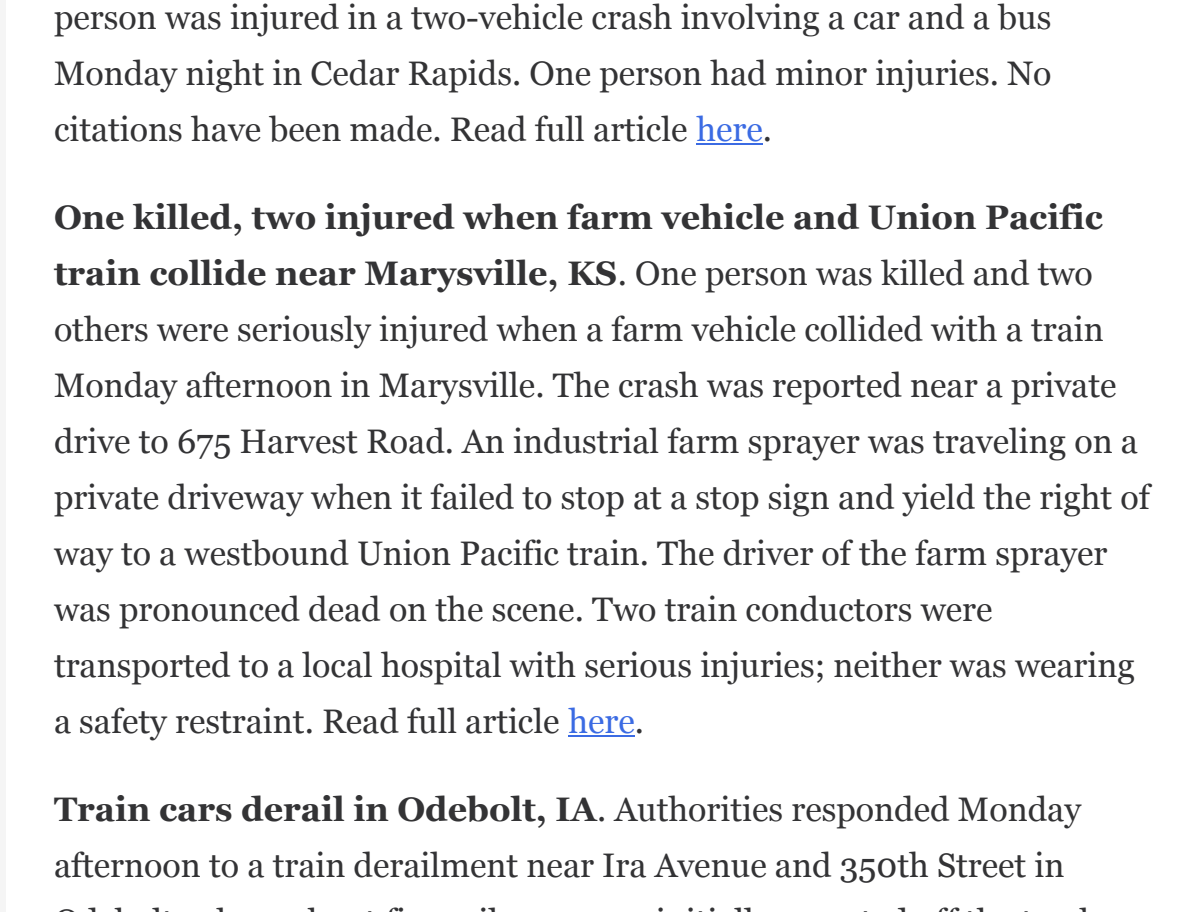
- Local crime is centered around property crimes including vehicle thefts with elevated activity in the evening hours coinciding with the end of matches.
- Local crime peaks in July, which coincides with the World Cup quarter-final schedule.

- The quarter-final match on 11 July and third place match on 18 July have elevated situational risk profiles due to symbolic targeting value and crowd density.
- Hard Rock Stadium was the site of a July 2024 Copa América security breach in which fans without tickets surged and overwhelmed security gaining access to the stadium, creating a hazardous situation for fans, and causing a match delay.

- Miami-Dade County conducted an extensive after-action report following the July 2024 security breach and will be applying revised strategies and security protocols during FIFA World Cup 2026.

## Recent transit-related incidents

### **Transit-related Accidents:**

**Teen girl killed by LIRR train in Massapequa, NY.** A teen girl died after being struck by a Long Island Rail Road train at the Massapequa station Monday afternoon. The collision took place when LIRR train 163 with scheduled service from Babylon to Penn Station struck the teen, who was not authorized to be on the tracks at the Massapequa station. No criminality is suspected. The teen was pronounced dead on the scene. Read full article [here](#).

**No injuries after crash between semi-trailer and Union Pacific train at crossing in Lufkin, TX.** The back end of a semi-truck hauling heavy equipment on a trailer was struck by a Union Pacific train on Monday evening at a Lufkin railroad crossing. First responders arrived at the crash at the Southwood Drive crossing. The semi-truck was hauling a tractor on its trailer, and the weight prevented the truck from navigating the crossing before the train collided. There were no reported injuries. **One injured in car and bus collision in Cedar Rapids, IA.** One person was injured in a two-vehicle crash involving a car and a bus Monday night in Cedar Rapids. One person had minor injuries. No citations have been made. Read full article [here](#).

**One killed, two injured when farm vehicle and Union Pacific train collide near Marysville, KS.** One person was killed and two others were seriously injured when a farm vehicle collided with a train Monday afternoon in Marysville. The crash was reported near a private drive to 675 Harvest Road. An industrial farm sprayer was traveling on a private driveway when it failed to stop at a stop sign and yield the right of way to a westbound Union Pacific train. The driver of the farm sprayer was pronounced dead on the scene. Two train conductors were transported to a local hospital with serious injuries; neither was wearing a safety restraint. **Train cars derail in Odebolt, IA.** Authorities responded Monday afternoon to a train derailment near Ira Avenue and 350th Street in Odebolt, where about five rail cars were initially reported off the tracks. No injuries were reported, and here were no reported leaks from the derailed cars. Crews worked Monday evening to clear the scene. Read full article [here](#).

### **Transit Crime:**

**Gunman wanted after fatally shooting man on MTA bus in the Bronx, NY.** New York City police are searching for a suspect after a man was fatally shot on an MTA bus in the Bronx on Monday afternoon. The victim was shot on a Bx36 bus at the intersection of East Tremont Avenue and White Plains Road in Van Nest. Investigators said the bus was moving when the gunman opened fire. The victim was shot in the abdomen after confronting the teen suspect for talking too loudly on his phone. The victim was transported to a local hospital, where he was pronounced dead. The gunman fled the scene on foot and is still at large. Read full article [here](#).

**Man hospitalized after stabbing at Bedford Park Blvd Subway Station in the Bronx, NY.** A man was stabbed in Bedford Park and hospitalized in the early hours of Monday morning. The victim was stabbed at Bedford Park subway station, serving the B & D trains. The victim was slashed on the left side of his forehead. He was transported to a local hospital for treatment in stable condition. The suspect is still at large. Read full article [here](#).

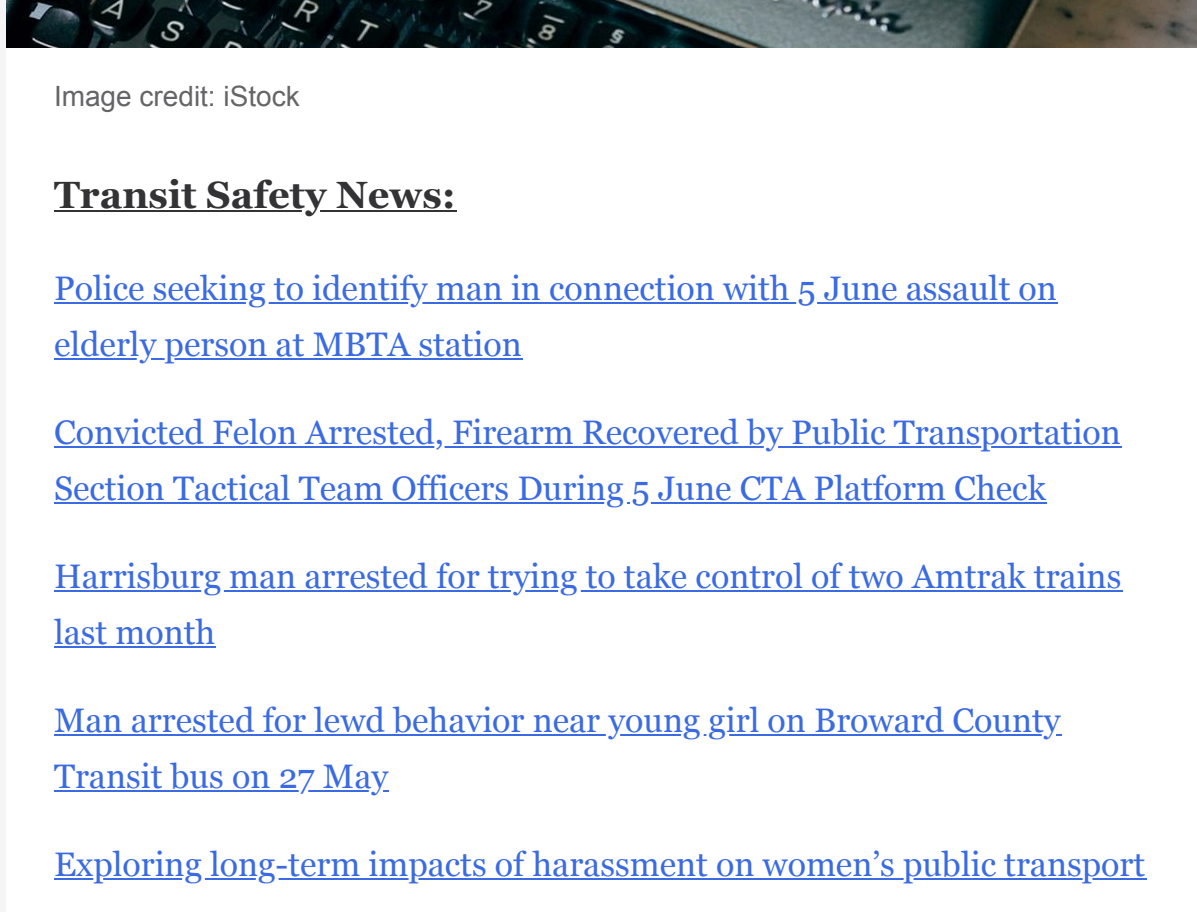
